2004 ECITPA Pulling Rules: Limited Pro Stock

- Contest is limited to 2 wheel drive pneumatic tired tractors
- Contestants must pay dues and be a member in good standing before pulling. Contestants under 21 must have written consent of parents or guardian and ECITPA Board of Directors. No one under 16 years of age will be allowed to drive.
- 3. Tractors may enter only once in each class.
- 4. Weight includes drive. Weight must be securely fastened. Weight may be certifled at designated pulls. A competing driver may ask to weigh the winning tractor with a tolerance of 2% allowed, if tractor is certified. When a tractor is weighed protestee and protester will be weighed.
- Each competitor will be allowed two attempts to make a measurable pull.
 - A. An attempt is defined as moving the sled a measurable distance (one inch or more)
 - B. On his/her first attempt, if competitor lets off on the throttle before going 100 feet, said competitor will get a second attempt, even if he went beyond the 100 foot mark.
 - C. If no attempt is made to back off the throttle, no second attempt will be grant.
- Note: Intent is for driver not to slam on brakes to stop before 100-foot mark (or any time) but to come to a smooth, safe stop.
 - D. Cleaning of the track is up to the driver after a false start.
- 6. A tractor that does not go 100 feet and stays inbounds will be given a second chance except on pull-offs, where a tractor has only one attempt no matter what distance pulled. If a driver has trouble with his tractor on the first attempt, he may drop to last and has only one attempt. If the sled operator resets the sled, the first puller may drop to last.
- The first tractor in each class has the option to come back in 3rd major position. The driver must tell the track judge before he moves away from the sled if he so wishes.
- No excessive jerking when starting or during pull.
- If tractor hitch breaks, the measurement will be taken at that point.
- Tractor pulling the farthest before stopping will be declared the winner of that class. Distance will be measured from front center of sled if manual measuring is required.
- 11. Pull is ended when forward motion stops or if tractor goes out of bounds. Excessive digging will not be tolerated.
- 12. Contest will be governed by a judge or judges with all decisions being final. Safety will be foremost consideration. Dangerous or unfair practices will be reason for disqualification. Any of the following "A" thru "L" while under the green flag will be automatic disqualification.
 - A. Driver does not remain seated.
 - B. Loss of weight while still hooked to the sled.
 - C. Loss of any safety equipment.
 - D. Loss of any shielding.
 - Any time the tractor goes out of bounds.
 - F. If driver shows any unsportsman like conduct the following will occur:

First offense: 0 pints will be awarded to the tractor for that class. Second offense: No points for both classes. Third offense: No points and no money for that day and barred from competition for a year and 1 day.

- G. Driver must wear shirt, shoes and full length pants before competing in the pull. Helmet and jacket are required.
- H. Severity of punishment is to be at the discretion of the ECITPA board of directors, although a major rules infraction such as illegal entry or flagrant violation of safety rule may cause contestant to be barred from competition for 1 year and 1 day from that date, and/or withdrawal of accumulated points.
- I. The ECITPA board of directors resume the right to change, correct, delete, or add any rules that might become necessary during any pulling season.
- J. On excessive alcohol consumption: First offense: Contestant does not compete that day and no points award.

 Second offense: Contestant does not compete that day and loss of points for 1 year.

 Third offense: Does not compete that day and loss of points for 1 year plus barred from competition for a year and 10 days.
- K. Excessive loss of fluids (coolant, motor oil, transmission oil, rear housing oil, water, etc.) while under the green flag.
- L. Driver leaves the tractor seat while in the staging area or any time the engine is running or is going to be started.
- 13. A point system will be used with points awarded to all competing member tractors at all sanctioned events. Tractors must hook to sled under own power and make an attempt to be eligible for points. Points are awarded in this manner:
 - 5 points To hook to sled as stated above
 - 10 points First Place
 - 9 Points Second Place
 - 8 Points Third Place
 - 7 Points Fourth Place

Down through 10 places, 1 being 10th Place Last place points will also be awarded to a tractor which is forced to scratch out of his/her second weight class due to breakage. The tractor doesn't have to hook in class to be awarded these points. No points for a class will be awarded unless the entire class is completed.

- Only one vote per tractor will be allowed when voting at meetings.
- 15. Helmets must be on in staging area and remain on until off the track.
- 16. No riders allowed on tractors—Drivers only!
- All non-member tractors may be teched at any time at any pull.
- 18. A floating finish line may be used the discretion of the ECITPA officials. A ten foot maximum. All competitors in a class must be notified before the start of that class. Notification will be posted at the weight scale,
- A tractor has a three minute time limit to get hooked to the sled when they are to pull.

2004 ECITPA Pulling Rules: Pro Farm

- All ECITPA Pro Farm tractors will be of a stock chassis, engine and frame configuration. Any deviation from this must get board approval.
- 2. Weight class will be as follows:

8000 lb. Pro Farm - 410 CID or less 9000 lb. Pro Farm - 410 CID or less 11000 lb. Pro Farm - 650 CID or less 12000 lb. Pro Farm - 650 CID or less

- Turbo chargers Add-on turbos are allowed. Only one turbo per tractor. There will be a \$500.00 claim on all turbos.
- RPM 3000 RPM or less will be enforced and measured off crankshaft with a hand held tachometer, any tractor found over 3000 RPMs after they have pulled will be disqualified immediately and without reimbursement.
- 5. Tire sizes: 8000 lb. and 9000 lb. classes 18.4 x 38 11000 lb. & 12000 lb. classes 20.8 x 38 or 18.4 x 42 max.Cut tires are legal.
- 6. PTO/HYD. Not required.
- 7. There will be no water/alcohol injection allowed.

- 10 mile per hour speed limit enforced. No Add on mph equipment. Pullers will have 150 ft. to get their speed regulated to 10 mph max. Speed will be policed by the sled or pace tractor if needed.
- No weight protruding beyond the rear tires. Hitch must be free and clear and able to reach with hook without excessive work. Sled operator has right to decline hook to any tractor regarding this matter.
- Plastic blades verses metal blades are acceptable but not mandatory.
- 11. Snuffers are mandatory.
- 12. Wheelie bars are mandatory and must be the same dimensions as Limited Pro Stock.
- If the speed limit horn sounds, driver may finish pull in a controlled fashion. Failure to do so will result in loss of previously accumulated points.
- 14. A sensor to check rpms is mandatory before the first pull. First time pullers get 1 courtesy hook without the sensor.
- 15. ECIPTA reserves the right to make any changes at any time to these rules.
- All other rules pertaining to contest rules are strictly enforced.




